

NA100: NURSE ASSISTANT TRAINING PROGRAM

CERTIFICATION COURSE, BELOW COLLEGE LEVEL

The Nurse Assistant Training Program consists of one hundred sixty (160) hours. The theoretical portion has sixty (60) hours of classroom instruction and the clinical portion has one hundred (100) hours. The training program will be conducted from Monday to Friday, Theory days 0800 –1630 hours, Clinical days 0600 –1430 hours, and accomplished in twenty (20) days. The maximum number of students per class is 15. The Instructor is an RN or LVN who is approved to instruct by the California Department of Public Health.

The instructors will teach the theory content through lectures, demonstrations, as well as exposing the students to actual nursing procedures and technicians while in the clinical setting. Knowledge validation is evaluated on an ongoing basis through tests and quizzes. The book titled “Hartman’s Nursing Assistant Care: The Basics” by Hartman Publishing 4th edition will be the official textbook for the course.

PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

- Be at least 16 years old
- Driver’s License or U.S. Passport
- Social Security Card
- Proof of U.S. grade 12 completion or equivalent: US High School, GED, 2-year degree, 4-year degree (these items must be an Official Transcript in a sealed envelope), or a Foreign Evaluation (an original in a sealed envelope)
- Medical-Physical: Fit for duty without restrictions. Performed within 12 months to program start date
- Tuberculosis Test: 2-step PPD or Chest X-Ray, 12-month exp.
- BCIA 8016: Live Scan (fingerprinting form needed by the California Dept. of Public Health)
- Analog Watch: Must have functioning minute and second hands
- Shoes: Simple, mostly black shoes that shed liquid; no open-toes or perforated materials

ADMISSION PROCEDURE

2. Submit all completed documentation as listed in the “Program Requirements” above
3. Complete the Student Performance Fact Sheet
4. Complete the Enrollment Agreement
5. Pay the non-refundable enrollment fees of \$105.00

FINANCIAL BREAKDOWN

- Total tuition amount is \$1,200.00
- First Installment on the 1st day of the course: \$400.00
- Second Installment on the 11th day of the course: \$400.00
- Third Installment on the 20th day of the course: \$400.00

OTHER EXPENSES AND EQUIPMENT

- Enrollment Fee \$50.00: The student pays this fee when they sign their Enrollment Agreement.
- Book Set \$55.00: The student pays this fee when they sign their Enrollment Agreement. Books received on first day of class.
- BCIA 8016 Live Scan ~\$43.00: Each student is responsible to complete their Live Scan for the CDPH prior to enrollment.
- Tuberculosis Test 2-step \$40.00: This item may be purchased and administered on campus OR submitted by the student. Students with positive PPD results may submit a chest x-ray result indicating that the student does not have active tuberculosis.
- Medical-Physical \$55.00: Performed on-campus. May submit copy of exam, 12 month expiration.
- American Red Cross Competency Evaluation Exam \$120.00: Each student will pay this fee to register themselves for the exam once they have received their completed CDPH-283B form.
